START TALKING. WITH AN ICEBREAKER QUESTION:

START THINKING. ASK QUESTIONS THAT WILL GET YOUR GROUP THINKING.

- Read Proverbs 13:20 aloud. Can your group quote it together?

Proverbs 13:20 (NIV)

He who walks with the wise grows wise, but a companion of fools suffers harm.

- This was written 1000's of years ago. Why has this truth stood the test of time?
- Why would someone be "a companion of fools?"
- How can someone tell if someone is wise or a fool?

START SHARING. CHOOSE THE QUESTIONS THAT WILL CREATE OPENNESS.

- If your life was a movie; what people in your life would be deserving of a supporting role? (i.e. your story could not be told without their influence being indicated)
- Who were the main influencers in your journey to knowing Christ?
- Who is someone in your life that has stood by you in good times and bad?
- Talk about a time when you saw someone suffer because of his or her relationships. What happened?
- Who is a person in your life whose wisdom you rely on? In what ways have you seen his or her wisdom rub off on you over time?
- If who you will become is greatly determined by those closest to you; what changes do you need to make to be who you want to be?

START PRAYING. BE BOLD, AND PRAY WITH POWER.

- Father, grant me wisdom to know the difference between a wise person and a fool, and the courage to make the wise choices with that knowledge. Amen.

START DOING. COMMIT TO A STEP AND LIVE IT OUT THIS WEEK.

- When around a fool this week, simply tell yourself, "I'm not emotionally mature enough to hang out with them," and then walk away.
